
In a time when words like amazing and masterful are flippantly thrown around to describe every record that is released, Wyatt Easterling's new album, From Where I Stand, rises above the fray and establishes the bar for releases this year.

From Where I Stand was started in 2019 and finished throughout the pandemic. While the quality of the album was certainly aided by the extra time and work allowed by the shutting down of the world, this is not just another "Covid album". Easterling says of the experience:

Starting with the title track and first single, Wyatt lets the listener know that he will be bringing them along on an emotional and glaringly human experience. Easterling's long lauded songwriting chops are on full display, touching on love, loss, moving on, freedom of speech and doing so with an honesty that every listener will latch onto.

Wyatt Easterling has a long history in all aspects of the music industry, songwriting, publishing, producing, as well as A&R for Atlantic Records. His work has help launch the careers of folks such as Paul Thorn, Keith Urban, and John Michael Montgomery. His successfull writing workshop in France, The Castle, brought in artists such as Cher, Bon Jovi, Peter Frampton and more. In short, Easterling knows how to write a great song.
